Tuition is due by the 1st of the month.

- 1. The regular studio calendar runs from mid-August through May. All tuition is due monthly even if a child is not in attendance during May. Rent, teachers, utilities and other studio bills need to be paid. ** Please refer to the withdrawal policy as outlined in the studio policies.
- 2. Summer schedules, beginning in June of each summer, have different tuition rates due to the number of consecutive teaching hours per day children are in class. Unfortunately, no scholarships or reduced tuition will be available for summer study starting June 2019.
- 3. The studio is not responsible for missed classes due to illness, family vacation, or sporting events that are committed to after the studio year has begun.
- 4. Make-up classes are not the responsibility of the studio unless the studio incurs large blocks of missed time for inclement weather or classes are cancelled due to instructor illness and only

if a substitute cannot be secured.

- 5. Please understand that there is no scholarship fund associated with the Shenandoah Academy of Dance. All assistance that I have and continue to try to offer families comes out of the studio's pocket (teacher salaries, rent, licenses, insurance, utilities, etc.). The studio NEEDS your tuition paid timely.
- 6. As of the 2018 / 2019 Studio Year and continuing forward, all tuition must be current for students to be allowed to perform with the Shenandoah Ballet. I regret having to continue to enforce this policy but, again this year, I am carrying so many past due balances that I just cannot afford. There are expenses associated with running a business.

7. Additional Fees:

\$15.00 Drop in class fee

\$10.00 Late fee if tuition is not paid by the 10th of the month.

As of 2018 / 2019, this will be an automated process. \$35.00 returned check fee. No exceptions.

Master Class fees will apply and will be on a case by case basis, depending on the rates charged by the Guest Artist(s) teaching. No exceptions. These extra fees strictly cover the Guest Artist(s). The studio usually pays a large portion of the fees associated with hiring Guest Artists, including but not limited to the security deposit required. Please note that the studio does not profit from master classes. I consider myself very lucky if I break even!
